- Maintain accurate student attendance records.
- Help with lunch supervision for grades 3-6.
- Motivate students to improve athletic fitness and build leadership skills.
- Drive the HRA student bus to and from the Alaska Club West on Northern Lights.

- Manage student behavior during PE class and apply appropriate disciplinary measures. Report all cases of inappropriate behavior to parents and input warnings and demerits into HRA's grading program in a timely manner.
- Demonstrate skills being taught and assist students in performing movements.
- Ensure the students respect the property and patrons of the Alaska Club Gym.
- Maintain an inventory of athletic equipment and submit new equipment requests as needed.
