Classical Curriculum

Juniors and seniors demonstrate rhetorical skills by carefully considering, artfully writing, and successfully defending a self-selected philosophical thesis topic. 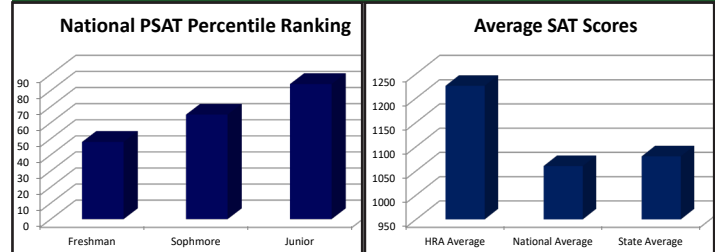
