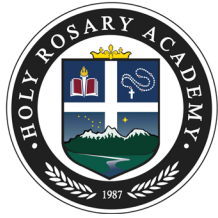

Mission/Philosophy

Holy Rosary Academy seeks to complete what the attentive parent has begun by forming students in faith, reason, and virtue through a classical education in the Roman Catholic tradition.

Religion

The Students study about their faith in every aspect of their day. Prayers begin and end each day; the rosary and weekly mass are their primary devotion. They study religion daily in the Image of God series and other texts. Finally, they learn Latin and English Prayers and study sacred music in their Music course.

Classical Curriculum

Elementary students embark on the first stage of the Trivium by learning the grammar of every subject such as the times tables in math, the scale in music and phonics in reading. The Core Knowledge sequence provides the basic content of their studies in many subjects. Primary school students begin study of Latin by third grade and Greek by the fifth grade to supplement their acquisition of language and strengthen their grasp of the parts of speech and diagramming the sentences. Reading, writing, and arithmetic lay the foundation and form the building blocks for the middle school transition.

History/National Recognition

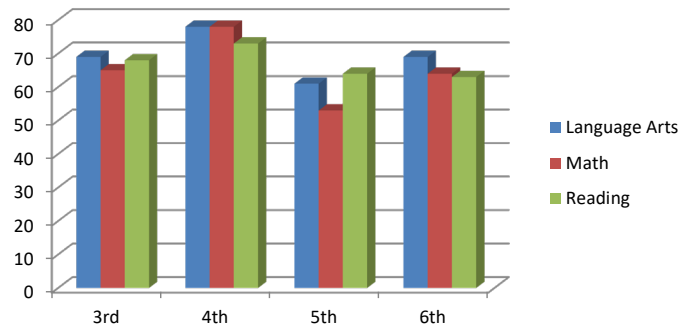
